

Private College/Out-of-State University Transfer

MiraCosta College has agreements with many private colleges and universities within California as well as with some out-of-state universities. Most of these universities accept all courses designated as UC transferable, and many accept completion of the California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC) pattern in lieu of their own general education requirements. However, graduation requirements and coursework used to complete a major may vary significantly from those at the California State University (CSU) or University of California (UC). Some California and out-of-state private colleges and universities accept the Associate Degree for Transfer (<http://catalog.miracosta.edu/degreecertificate/transferinfo/associatedegreefortransfer/>) for specific majors in lieu of major and general education requirements. Transfer Guarantee to Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) Program

Students who receive at least a 2.0* grade point average (GPA) and complete either an Associate Degree for Transfer (<http://catalog.miracosta.edu/degreecertificate/transferinfo/associatedegreefortransfer/>) or 30 UC or CSU transferable units are guaranteed transfer to a participating HBCU as part of the California Community Colleges partnership with 37 select public and private HBCUs. Most HBCUs are located in the South and on the East Coast, and they are open to students of all ethnicities.
