Any student who was enrolled at MiraCosta College but who has been absent for two or more primary terms (summer session not included) is required to submit a new free application for admission. Upon completion and submission of an application, students will be able to continue their studies. For catalog rights information, please refer to catalog forward or meet with an academic counselor.

Service members of an active or reserve United States military service who receive orders compelling a withdraw from courses are afforded the opportunity to continue their studies and will be able to maintain the same academic status they had when they last attended, whether they were out one or more terms (fall or spring). For any student who is out two or more primary terms will also need to submit a new free application for admission. For any student where the program (major of study) the student was enrolled in is no longer available or for which catalog rights have changed, the student may enroll into the most closely related program to minimize any disruption toward finishing their educational goals. *(Added November 2023)*
